Dear Parents and Carers

Backwell School Production – Matinee Performance Friday 9 February 2018

I am sure many of you are aware that the school is currently preparing for our next Backwell School Production which will be taking place in the last week of this term.

On Friday 9 February we will be holding both a matinee and evening performance. This date is the last day of term and so;

- School will finish early for **all** students at 12.50pm.
- School coaches will depart at 1.00pm
- The matinee performance will begin at 2.00pm with access to the school site and car park for the audience from 1.30pm (the school site will be inaccessible between 1.00-1.30pm).
- Students involved in the production will stay in school and will be supervised by the Drama staff. Food will be provided between the matinee and evening performances.
- Students who will be attending the matinee performance have the option to remain at school and can wait in their house blocks. They will need to bring food with them or purchase something from the canteen at break time. Otherwise they can travel home and return from 1.30pm with you as a family if there is sufficient time.
- All students entitled to Free School Meals will be able to collect a packed lunch from the main canteen at break time.

Backwell School productions are popular and so this matinee is being offered to provide additional tickets to enable students and their families to enjoy the talents, hard work and dedication of so many of our students and staff.
